The Conference theme has been inspired by a statement by Mustafa Kemal Atatürk about the ANZACs which was given on his behalf by Sükrü Kaya, Minister of the Interior in 1934. It is inscribed on the Gallipoli Fountains of Honour, Brisbane, Queensland, Australia and the Memorial at ANZAC Cove, Turkey:

"Those heroes that shed their blood and lost their lives ... You are now lying in the soil of a friendly country; therefore rest in peace. There is no difference between the Johnnies and the Mehmet to us where they lie side by side here, in this country of ours"

This conference includes the Dawn Service at Gallipoli on 25 April 2006. Pre and Post conference tours of the region will be available.
