Avuavu High School is the only senior high school on the Weather Coast of Guadalcanal in Solomon Islands. It currently enrolls 400 students from Forms 1 to 7 (Grades 7 to university preparatory year). The Weather Coast has a population of about 18,000 people. The students come from all over Guadalcanal and Solomon Islands. Avuavu is a boarding school, so the students live on campus for nine months a year.

Up until now, the school never had a library building. Thanks to students and staff, the school now has a new library. It was built with school fees and funds that the students and staff raised. We are proud of our new library building.



**But, there are no books. So, we need your assistance. Please donate books.**

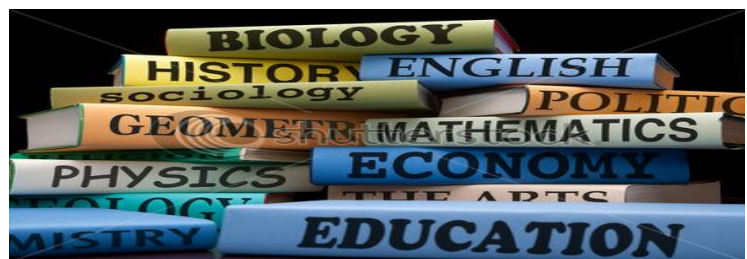
The library will also serve students from the nearby primary schools. We therefore request books appropriate for Kindergarten and primary schools students, as well as high school and university preparatory year.
