What is Māori Language Week?

Every year since 1975, New Zealand has marked Māori Language Week in order to celebrate Te Reo Māori (The Māori Language). The ANUNZ Students' society would like to further promote the history of Te Reo Māori to Australian (Canberra) communities and thus provide an informative and interesting experience through film in this instance. Therefore, we have chosen to screen a critically acclaimed New Zealand film based around Māori Culture (The Dead Lands – 2014).

Synopsis of Film:

Set in pre-colonial New Zealand, 'The Dead Lands' brings Māori history to life in an epic, brutal experience. After his tribe is slaughtered through an act of treachery, the teenage son of a slain Māori chieftain (Hongi) looks to avenge his father's murder and bring peace and honour to the souls of his loved ones. Vastly outnumbered by a band of villains led by Wirepa, Hongi's only hope is to pass through the feared and forbidden Dead Lands and forge an uneasy alliance with the mysterious "Warrior", a ruthless fighter who has ruled the area for years.
