### **Commercial Environmental Forestry: Tools for targeting, assessment, monitoring and accounting of the commercial and environmental benefits of forest plantations**

The Ensis and Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry have recently completed the three year Commercial Environmental Forestry programme. This project has developed several tools to enable planners at catchment and farm scale to understand and predict outcomes associated with establishment of plantations and other forms of revegetation.

Ensis has developed the Scenario Planning and Investment Framework tool which will help to maximise the impact and efficiency of commonwealth investment on the environment by targeting where to focus investment and measure the expected environmental and economic outcomes. The tool was recently launched by Senator Eric Abetz and has been gaining increasing interest as an accounting tool for environmental and economic flows.
